BUILDING BRIDGES OF PEACE THROUGH DIALOGUE

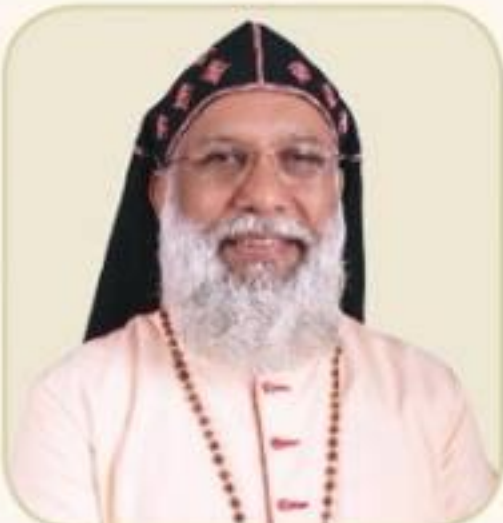

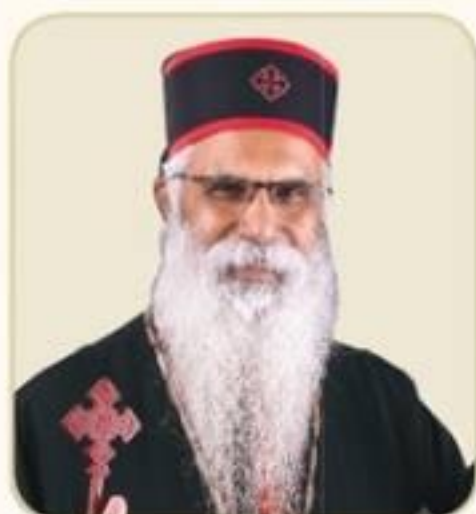

-  Develop and share practical models of interfaith cooperation for social service, education, and community development.



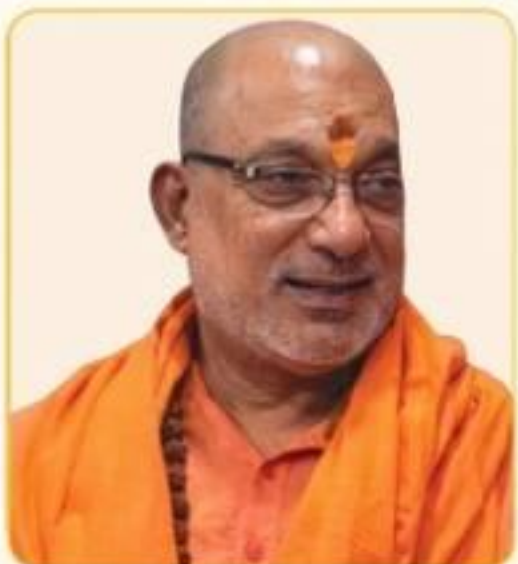
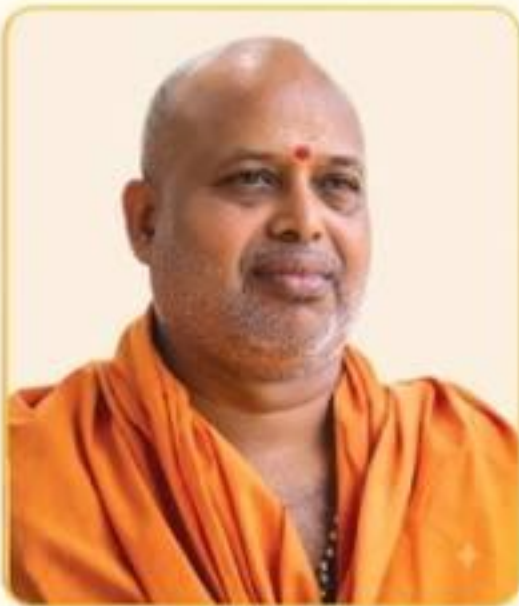
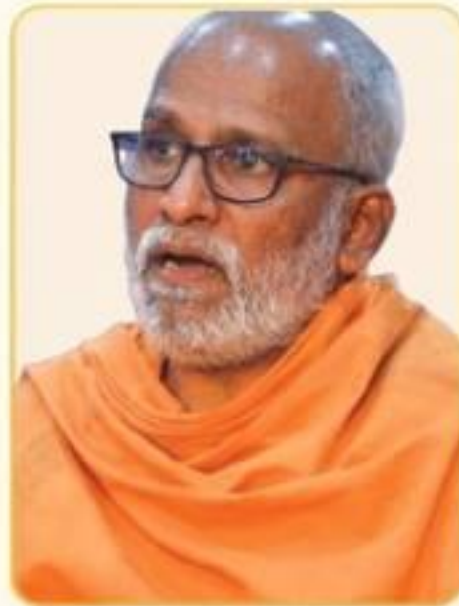
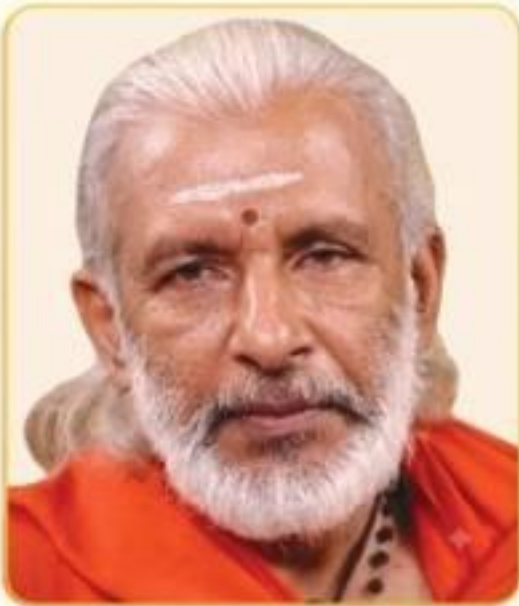
